### Who should Attend?

Facilitators who have been trained to use ACT Against Violence materials (either original ACT materials for parents and teachers) or Parents Raising Safe Kids materials.

The goal of the ACT Against Violence Training program is to make early violence prevention a central and ongoing part of a community's efforts to prevent violence.

Its purpose is to train professionals to teach violence prevention skills to parents, caregivers, teachers and other adults working with young children from birth to age 8.

The ACT Training Program was developed by the American Psychological Association (APA) and the National Association for the Education of Younger Children (NAEYC) with assistance from child development and violence prevention experts.

This regional trainer update will provide the opportunity to hear from experts, network with other trainers to share program ideas and receive updated training and evaluation materials and resources.

## Guest Speakers

Tamra Schwartz, LCSW is an ACT facilitator trainer. Tamra will review the new training manuals (both English and Spanish) as well as discuss two new additions to the training materials—Motivational Interviewing and the Children's Activity Guide (which are in English only)
